Canterbury Charity Hospital

The Canterbury Charity Hospital Trust provides FREE elective day surgery and medical outpatient clinics for those in our Canterbury community who can't access these services through the public health system because they:

- Don't qualify for the public health waiting list.
- Don't have medical insurance.
- Don't have any other means of covering the cost of their treatment.

Our surgical services include:

- Colonoscopy
- General surgery (abdominal and lower colorectal surgery)
- Vascular surgery (varicose veins)
- Gynaecology, women's health and family planning
- Ophthalmology (eyes)
- Orthopaedics (hands, elbows, minor shoulder)
- Vascular surgery
- Oral surgery (dentistry and dental prosthetics for WINZ clients)

We also provide counselling for adults.



Training and Education

The hospital provides professional development and education for clinicians, student nurses and other health professionals. Our interactive technology in our two theatres enables us to also run educational seminars.

Why are our services free?

Thanks to our wonderful team of unpaid volunteer surgeons, dentists, nurses, clinicians and other support staff, we can offer these free services to the people of Canterbury.

We also rely on funding from a range of trusts and organisations, along with bequests and donations from the public. We receive NO government funding.



How do you access these services?

- You will need a referral from your GP/family doctor or dentist. Only counselling patients may self-refer.
- You will also need to provide some background information on your financial situation or proof that you are a WINZ client for our dentistry services.

Where can I find more information?
